# The Isle of Man Police Pay and Allowances Determination, 1970

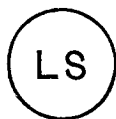

The Isle of Man Police Board in pursuance of Section 10(1)(c) of the Police (Isle of Man) Act, 1962, after consultation with the Governor, the Finance Board and the Isle of Man Police Federation, DO hereby determine as follows:

1. As from 1st September, 1969, for the rates of Subsistence, Refreshment and Lodging allowances as set out in Schedule 5 of the Isle of Man Police Regulations, 1968, and as determined by the Isle of Man Police Board by the Isle of Man Police Pay and Allowances Determination, 1967, there shall be substituted the rates set out in Appendix 4 of the draft Isle of Man Police (Amendment) Regulations proposed to be made by His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor (a copy of which is appended).
2. As from 1st January, 1970, the rates of pay of members of the Isle of Man Constabulary shall be as set out at Appendix 1 to the draft Isle of Man Police (Amendment) Regulations in place of the rates set out at Schedule 3 to the Isle of Man Police Regulations, 1968, and as determined by the Isle of Man Police Board by the Isle of Man Police Pay and Allowances Determination, 1969.
3. As from 1st January, 1970, the rates of detective duty and supplementary detective allowances payable to members of the Constabulary shall be as set out at Appendix 2 to the draft Isle of Man Police (Amendment) Regulations, 1970, in place of those set out at Schedule 4 to the Isle of Man Police Regulations, 1968, and as determined by the Isle of Man Police Board by the Isle of Man Police Pay and Allowances Determination 1969.
4. As from 1st April, 1970, the rates of detective duty and supplementary detective allowances as determined by Article 3 of this Determination and as set out at Appendix 2 to the draft Isle of Man Police (Amendment) Regulations, 1970, shall have effect subject to the amendments set out at Appendix 3 to those Regulations.

5. As from 1st April, 1970, the scales of annual leave granted to members of the Constabulary shall be as set out in Appendix 5 to the draft Isle of Man Police (Amendment) Regulations 1970 in place of those set out in Schedule 2 to the Isle of Man Police Regulations 1968.

6. This determination may be cited as the Isle of Man Police Pay and Allowances Determination, 1970, and shall come into operation on the same being approved by Tynwald.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Determination)*

The draft Isle of Man Police (Amendment) Regulations (G.C. No. 34/70) to which this Determination refers, provides for increased rates of Subsistence, Refreshment and Lodging Allowances from 1st September, 1969, together with increased rates of pay from 1st January, 1970, and increased rates of detective duty and supplementary detective allowances in two stages from 1st January, 1970 and 1st April, 1970. The draft Regulations also provide that with effect from 1st April, 1970, all officers below the rank of superintendent shall be granted two rest days in every week.
