The Isle of Man Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations 1970

ISLE OF MAN TO WIT

By His Excellency Sir Peter Hyla Gawne Stallard, K.C.M.G., C.V.O., M.B.E.,
Lieutenant Governor of the said Isle, &c., &c., &c.

I the said Lieutenant Governor in pursuance of the powers vested in me, hereby make the following Regulations :—

PAY.

1. For the Table in Schedule 1 to the Isle of Man Police Cadets Regulations 1968 (which contains scale of pay), there shall be substituted the following Table:—

“TABLE

Age	
Under 17 years	£408 a year
17 years	£444 a year
18 years	£501 a year
19 years	£552 a year.”

CHARGE FOR BOARD AND LODGING

2. For Schedule 2 to the Isle of Man Police Cadets Regulations 1968 (which relates to rate of charge for board and lodging), there shall be substituted the following Schedule:—

“SCHEDULE 2

CHARGE FOR BOARD AND LODGING

The annual rate of charge for board and lodging shall be £96. os. od.”

OPERATION AND EFFECT

3. (1) These Regulations shall come into operation on the date hereof, and shall have effect from 1st January 1970.

CITATION

4. These Regulations may be cited as The Isle of Man Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations 1970.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Isle of Man Police Cadets Regulations, 1968.

Regulation 1 increases the pay of a police cadet by £18 to £47 a year depending on his age.

Regulation 2 increases the charge for board and lodging by £2 10s. od. a year.
