THE ISLE OF MAN POLICE CADETS (AMENDMENT)(NO.2)

REGULATIONS, 1970

C.V.O., M.B.E., Lieutenant Governor of the said Isle,

I the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 16 of the Police (Isle of Man) Act 1962 hereby make the following Regulations:-

1. In Regulation 4(2) of the Isle of Man Police Cadet Regulations 1968 (normal weekly period of duty) for the period '42 hours' there shall be substituted '40 hours'.
2. These Regulations shall come into operation on the date hereof and shall have effect from 1st April, 1970.
3. These Regulations may be cited as the Isle of Man Police Cadets (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1970.
