CREMATION ACT, 1957

THE CREMATION REGULATIONS, 1970

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by section 6 of the Cremation Act, 1957, DO HEREBY make the following Regulations:-

1. In these Regulations the expression "medical practitioner" means a person fully registered within the meaning or for the purposes of the Medical Act, 1958, or any Act amending that Act.

2. The fees which may be charged by a medical practitioner in respect of the issue of any medical certificates required under the Cremation Regulations, 1957, shall be as follows:-

For a certificate in Form B
set out in the Schedule thereto £3. 3. 0.

For a certificate in Form C
set out in the Schedule thereto £3. 3. 0.

For a certificate in Form D
set out in the Schedule thereto £4. 4. 0.

3. The Cremation Regulations 1961* are hereby revoked.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Cremation Regulations, 1970, and shall come into force when approved by Resolution of Tynwald.
