THE POLICE (ISLE OF MAN) ACT, 1962.

THE ISLE OF MAN POLICE PAY AND
ALLOWANCES DETERMINATION (NO.2) 1970

The Isle of Man Police Board in pursuance of Section 1C(1)(c) of the Police (Isle of Man) Act, 1962, after consultation with the Governor, the Finance Board and the Isle of Man Police Federation, DO hereby determine as follows:

1. As from 1st January, 1970, the rates of pay of members of the Isle of Man Constabulary above the rank of constable shall be as set out at Appendix 1 to the draft Isle of Man Police (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations in place of the rates set out at Schedule 3 to the Isle of Man Police Regulations, 1968, and as determined by the Isle of Man Police Board by the Isle of Man Police Pay and Allowances Determination, 1970.
2. As from 1st April, 1970, the rates of plain clothes allowances payable to members of the Constabulary shall be as set out at Regulation 2 to the draft Isle of Man Police (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1970, in place of those set out at Schedule 4 to the Isle of Man Police Regulations, 1968, and as determined by the Isle of Man Police Board by the Isle of Man Police Pay and Allowances Determination 1968.
3. This Determination may be cited as the Isle of Man Police Pay and Allowances Determination (No. 2) 1970, and shall come into operation on the same being approved by Tynwald.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Determination)

The draft Isle of Man Police (Amendment)(No. 2) Regulations (G.C. No. 45/70) to which this Determination refers, provides for increased rates of pay from 1st January, 1970, in respect of the rank of Superintendent, together with increased rates of plain clothes allowances from 1st April, 1970.
