BETTING ACT 1970

BETTING ACT 1970 (APPOINTED DAY) (NO. 3)
ORDER 1970.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by section 13 (2) of the Betting Act 1970 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:-

1. The Appointed Day for the purposes of section 4 of the Act shall be the 1st day of January 1971.
2. This Order may be cited as The Betting Act 1970 (Appointed Day) (No.3) Order 1970.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport)

This Order brings into operation, with effect from 1st January 1971, section 4 of the Betting Act 1970 which increases penalties for street betting.
