**THE NATIONAL HEALTH  
SERVICE CONTRIBUTIONS  
ORDER 1970**

---

The National Health Service Contributions Order 1970, made by the Lieutenant Governor on 2nd June 1970 under the powers conferred upon him by subsection (1) of section 3 of the National Health Service Contributions (Isle of man) Act 1958, and approved by resolution of Tynwald on 16th June 1970.

## Explanatory Memorandum

1. The National Health Service Contributions (Isle of Man) Act, 1958 empowers the Governor, by order, to amend, vary or repeal any of the provisions of the National Health Service Contributions (Isle of Man) Act 1957 and the First Schedule to the National Health Service Contributions (Isle of Man) Act 1958 in such manner as may appear to him expedient for the purpose of making such enactments correspond (subject to such modifications or adaptations as he may consider appropriate) with the like enactments from time to time operating in Great Britain, and such an order may be varied or revoked by a subsequent order. The provisions of an order may be made retrospective and shall take effect on such day or days as may be specified in the order, not being earlier than the date from which the corresponding enactments have effect in Great Britain. Any such order must be laid before Tynwald as soon as may be after it is made but shall not take effect until approved by resolution of Tynwald. When such an order has been approved by resolution of Tynwald it has effect as if it were an Act of Tynwald.

2. The provisions of this Order correspond to those enacted in Great Britain by the National Health Service Contributions Act 1970.

3. This Order increases the amount of the weekly national health service contribution to be paid by an employer in respect of each person employed by him from 8d. to 1s. 8d.

4. The existing rates of national health service contributions and those prescribed by this Order are as follows:—

5. It is estimated that the effect of this Order will be to increase the yield from national health service contributions, after deduction of the expenses attributable to the collection of the contributions, by £45,000 in a full year. The increase in the period from 6th July 1970 (when this Order will take effect) to 31st March 1971 is estimated at £33,000.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by subsection (1) of section 3 of the National Health Service Contributions (Isle of Man) Act 1958 and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, DO hereby make the following Order:—

**1.** (1) The national health service contributions payable by employers shall be at the rate of 1s. 8d. a week instead of 8d. a week; and accordingly in the provisions having effect as the First Schedule to the National Health Service Contributions (Isle of Man) Act 1957 (that is to say, the provisions set out in the Schedule to the National Health Service Contributions Order 1968) a reference to 1s. 8d. shall be substituted for the reference to 8d. in the second column in paragraph 4.

(2) There shall be paid out of moneys provided by Tynwald any increase attributable to this section in the sums so payable under section 4 (4) of the National Health Service Contributions (Isle of Man) Act 1957 (which provides for financial adjustments with Great Britain and Northern Ireland in respect of members of the forces and seamen).

**2.** (1) This Order may be cited as the National Health Service Contributions Order 1970 and the National Health

Service Contributions (Isle of Man) Acts 1957 to 1968 and this Order may be cited together as the National Health Service Contributions (Isle of Man) Acts 1957 to 1970.

(2) This Order shall take effect on 6th July 1970.
