THE PUBLIC AUTHORITIES ACQUISITION OF LAND
(FEES) ORDER, 1970.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in pursuance of
the powers conferred on me by section 6(6) of the
Public Authorities Acquisition of Land Act, 1923,
DO HEREBY ORDER that the following fees shall be
charged in respect of proceedings before Official
Arbitrators under the said Act:-

1. Appointment Fee ... £ 3. 3. 0.
Fee, per hour, for all time
spent in connection with the
arbitration, whether at a
hearing or otherwise. ... £ 5. 5. 0.
Subject to a minimum
inclusive fee of ... £15.15. 0.
2. In addition to the foregoing
fees there shall be paid the
expenses incurred by the
arbitrators in hiring a room
for the hearing, and their
travelling expenses in viewing
property to be acquired.
3. The foregoing fees shall be paid
to the Treasurer of the Isle of Man.
4. The Public Authorities Acquisition of
Land (Fees) Order, 1945 is hereby revoked.
5. This Order may be cited as the Public
Authorities Acquisition of Land (Fees)
Order, 1970 and shall come into operation
on the date hereunder.
