CUSTOMS

The Customs (Import Deposits) (No. 2) Scheme 1970

1. (1) This Scheme may be cited as the Customs (Import Deposits) (No. 2) Scheme 1970, and shall be construed as one with the Customs (Import Deposits) Schemes 1969 and 1970, and those Schemes and this Scheme may together be cited as the Customs (Import Deposits) Schemes 1969 and 1970.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1970 shall apply for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Tynwald.
- (3) This Scheme shall be deemed to have had effect from the 1st day of September, 1970.
2. The amount of the import deposit payable in respect of any goods by virtue of sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 1 of the Customs (Import Deposits) Scheme 1969 as amended by the Customs (Import Deposits) (No. 2) Scheme 1969 and the Customs (Import Deposits) Scheme 1970 is hereby reduced from thirty per cent. to twenty per cent.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Scheme)

This Scheme reduces to 20 per cent. the amount of import deposit payable on imported goods entered with the Customs on or after 1st September 1970.

The Scheme was approved by Tynwald on the 20th October, 1970.
