The post of Assistant Surveyor (Footpaths) to be redesignated Assistant Engineer (Footpaths). The salary scale attaching to the post to be the same as the salary scale of the other Assistant Engineers. The holder of the post of Assistant Engineer (Footpaths) is to continue to receive his present salary and, subject to his passing the Proficiency Bar Examination, or on completion of fourteen years satisfactory service, he shall be eligible to proceed beyond the Proficiency Bar point on the revised salary scale.

The Assistant Engineers of the Harbour and Water Boards shall be deemed to have passed the Proficiency Bar examination.

The Proficiency Bar Examination shall consist of Part I of the Council of Engineering Institution, or such equivalent qualification as shall be appropriate in the prevailing circumstances.
