ADVOCATES ACTS (APPROVED UNIVERSITIES) ORDER, 1970.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 13 of the Advocates Act, 1874, as substituted by section 2 of the Advocates Act, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the 'said section'), DO hereby Order as follows:-

1. The following Universities shall be added to the list contained in the said section:

East Anglia
Essex
Exeter
Keele
Kent
Lancaster
Leicester
Newcastle-upon-Tyne
Sussex
York

2. This Order may be cited as the Advocates Act (Approved Universities) Order, 1970, and shall take effect when approved by resolution of Tynwald.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

Under section 13 of the Advocates Act, 1874 as substituted by section 2 of the Advocates Act, 1956, persons who, before entering into articles, have taken a degree (not being an honorary degree) in the Arts, Law, Science, Economics or Commerce at certain Universities, may be eligible to have the term of their articles reduced from five years to three years. This Order adds further Universities to the list contained in the Act.
