THE ALIENS (PLACES OF DETENTION) REGULATIONS 1970

I, the said Lieutenant Governor in pursuance of section 1(1)(g) of the Aliens Restriction Act 1948 and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf DO HEREBY make the following Regulations:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Aliens (Places of Detention) Regulations 1970 and shall be construed as one with the Aliens Regulations 1959 as amended by the Aliens (Amendment) Regulations 1960, and those Regulations and these Regulations may be together cited as the Aliens Regulations 1959 to 1970.

2. The places in which aliens shall be detained under the provisions hereinafter mentioned of the Aliens Regulations 1959, as amended, shall be -

(a) in the case of an alien detained under Regulation 7(3) of the said Regulations (which provides for the examination of aliens seeking to land in the Isle of Man) or under Regulation 8(4) of the said Regulations (which relates to aliens to whom leave to land has been refused) -

(i) any place used by an immigration officer for the purposes of his functions at the port at which the alien is seeking to land or has been refused leave to land, as the case may be; or

(ii) any place specially provided for the purpose of detention at any port; or

(iii) any police station, prison, remand home or remand centre;

(b) in the case of an alien detained under Regulation 8(4) of the said Regulations as applied by Regulation 9 thereof (which Regulation, as so applied, relates to aliens who have landed unlawfully in the Isle of Man and to certain alien seamen), any such place as is mentioned in subparagraph (a)(ii) or (iii) above;

(c) in the case of an alien detained under Regulation 21(4) of the said Regulations by reason of the giving of a certificate by a court recommending the making of a deportation order or by the making of such a deportation order, any such place as is mentioned in sub-paragraph (a)(iii) above;

3. An alien shall not be detained under the provisions aforesaid for more than five days elsewhere than in a prison, remand home or remand centre.

4. The Aliens (Detention) Order 1959 and the Aliens (places of Detention) Order 1962 are hereby revoked.
