THE POLICE (ISLE OF MAN) ACT, 1962

THE ISLE OF MAN POLICE PAY AND
ALLOWANCES DETERMINATION (No. 3) 1970

The Isle of Man Police Board in pursuance of Section 10(1)(c) of the Police (Isle of Man) Act, 1962, after consultation with the Governor, the Finance Board and the Isle of Man Police Federation DO hereby determine as follows:

1. The salary for the post of Chief Constable shall be as set out below:

2. This Determination may be cited as the Isle of Man Police Pay and Allowances Determination (No. 3) 1970, and shall come into operation on the same being approved by Tynwald.

This Determination increases the pay of the Chief Constable by approximately $3\frac{1}{2}\%$ as from 1st August, 1969, and condenses the scale with increases from 1st January, 1970.
