THE ISLE OF MAN POLICE (AMENDMENT)  
(NO. 4) REGULATIONS 1970.

I the said Lieutenant Governor in exercise of the  
powers conferred on me by Section 16 of the Police (Isle  
of Man) Act, 1962, hereby make the following Regulations:

Amendment taking effect from 1st August, 1969.

1. For the entry relating to the pay of the Chief  
Constable in the table set out in Paragraph 1 of Part 1  
of Schedule 3 of the Isle of Man Police Regulations,  
1968, as amended, there shall be substituted the  
following:-

	Before completing 1 year of service in the rank	After 1 year of service in the rank	After 2 years of service in the rank	Further incre- ments
Chief Constable	a year £2,525	a year £2,620	a year £2,710	£2,805 £2,900

Amendment taking effect from 1st January, 1970.

2. For the entry relating to the pay of the Chief  
Constable in the table set out in Paragraph 1 of Part 1  
of Schedule 3 of the Isle of Man Police Regulations 1968,  
as amended, there shall be substituted the following:-

Rank	Before completing 1 year of service in the rank	After 1 year of service in the rank	After 2 years of service in the rank
Chief Constable	£2,810	£2,905	£3,005

3. These Regulations shall come into operation and have effect as herein provided, that is to say -

- (a) For the purposes of Regulation 1 they shall come into operation on the date hereof and have effect as from 1st August, 1969;
- (b) for the purposes of Regulation 2 they shall come into operation on the date hereof and have effect as from 1st January, 1970.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Isle of Man Police (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations 1970.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations).

These Regulations amend the existing Regulations, by providing for increased rates of pay for the Chief Constable as from 1st August, 1969, and 1st January, 1970.
