SALE OF FIREWORKS (REGULATIONS) (AMENDMENT)

ORDER, 1970.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor in exercise of the power conferred upon me by section 4(1) of the Dangerous Goods Act 1928, and of all other powers me in this behalf enabling DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:

1. The following Regulations shall apply to the sale of fireworks -

- (1) A person shall not sell any firework (other than amorces and toy pistol caps) to any person who has not attained the age of 18 years;
- (2) A person who has not attained the age of 18 years shall not purchase any firework (other than amorces and toy pistol caps);
- (3) These Regulations may be cited as the Sale of Fireworks (No.2) Regulations 1970.

2. The Sale of Fireworks (Regulations) Order 1970 is hereby revoked.

3. This Order may be cited as the Sale of Fireworks (Regulations) (Amendment) Order 1970 and shall take effect when the same shall be approved by resolution of Tynwald.
