CIVIL AVIATION ACT, 1949

THE CIVIL AVIATION (CUSTOMS AIRPORTS) ORDER, 1970

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of my powers under Article 71 of the Air Navigation Order 1966 (a) as applied to the Isle of Man by the Air Navigation (Isle of Man) Order 1969 (b) DO HEREBY make the following Order:-

1. Ronaldsway (Isle of Man) Airport is hereby designated to be a place for the landing or departure of aircraft for the purpose of the enactments for the time being in force relating to customs.
2. Jurby Airport is hereby designated to be a place for the landing or departure of aircraft for the purpose of the enactments for the time being in force relating to customs whenever Ronaldsway (Isle of Man) Airport is non-operational due to weather or other conditions.
3. This Order may be cited as the Civil Aviation (Customs Airports) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on the date hereof.
