CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSONS ACT, 1966

THE JUVENILE COURTS (CONSTITUTION) RULES, 1970

I the said Lieutenant Governor in exercise of the powers and authorities me in this behalf enabling, under the Second Schedule to the Children and Young Persons Act, 1966, and of all other powers, DO HEREBY make the following Rules:-

1. These Rules may be cited as the Juvenile Courts (Constitution) Rules, 1970 and shall be construed as one with the Juvenile Courts (Constitution) Rules, 1961 and 1967 and those Rules and these Rules may be together cited as the Juvenile Courts (Constitution) Rules, 1961 to 1970.

2. The following Rule shall be inserted after Rule 3 of the Juvenile Courts (Constitution) Rules, 1961, as amended:-

"3A. The High Bailiff shall be ex-officio a member of the Juvenile Panel. "

3. These Rules shall come into operation on the date hereof.
