THE COINAGE (MANX CROWNS) ACT, 1970

THE MANX CROWNS (DESIGN) ORDER, 1970

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by section three of the Coinage (Manx Crowns) Act, 1970, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, after consultation with the Finance Board, hereby make the following Order :-

1. (1) This Order may be cited as The Manx Crowns (Design) Order, 1970.
 - (2) The Interpretation Act, 1970, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Tynwald.
 - (3) This Order shall come into operation on the date hereof.
2. The design for Manx Crowns shall be -
 - (a) On the obverse of the coins a representation of the portrait of Her Majesty the Queen by Mr. Arnold Machin, O.B.E., and the words "ELIZABETH THE SECOND"; and
 - (b) On the reverse of the coins a representation of the Manx Cat design by Mr. Christopher Ironside and the words "ISLE OF MAN ONE CROWN 1970".
