THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACTS, 1951 to 1966.
ELECTION RULES AMENDMENT ORDER 1970.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 7 of the Representation of the People Act 1966, DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:-

Citation and Interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Election Rules Amendment Order 1970.

(2) In this Order the expression "Election Rules" means the Election Rules set forth in the Fourth Schedule and the Appendix thereto to the Representation of the People Act 1951 as amended by sections 4, 5 and 6 and Schedules I and II to the Representation of the People Act 1966, section 16(3)(a) of and the Second Schedule to the Education Act 1968, the Election Rules Amendment Order 1966, the Election Rules Amendment (No.2) Order 1966, the Election Rules Amendment Order 1968 and the Election Rules Amendment Order 1969.

(3) The provisions of the Interpretation Act, 1970 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as they apply to the interpretation of an Act of Tynwald.

2. At the end of Rule 4A there shall be added the following paragraph -

"(3) In a case where the writs for more than one bye-election are issued on the same day the Notice of Election shall be a composite notice relating to all the constituencies to which such writs relate."

3. This Order shall come into force upon the same being approved by resolution of Tynwald.
