PAYMENT OF MEMBERS' EXPENSES ACTS, 1957 and 1962

PAYMENT OF MEMBERS' EXPENSES ORDER, 1970

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 9 of the Payment of Members' Expenses Act, 1957, hereby make the following Order.

1. The annual sum payable in terms of Section 1 (1) (a) of the Act shall be the sum of seven hundred pounds.
2. The further annual sum payable in terms of Section 1 (1) (b) of the Act shall be the sum of five hundred and fifty pounds.
3. The further annual sum payable in terms of Section 1 (1) (c) of the Act shall be the sum of two hundred pounds.

4. The further annual sum payable in terms of Section 1 (1) (d) of the Act to each member of the Executive Council who is Chairman of a Board of Tynwald, a Commercial Board or the Civil Defence Commission shall be the sum of one hundred pounds.

5. The further annual sum payable in terms of Section 1 (1) (d) of the Act to each member of the Executive Council who is not Chairman of a Board of Tynwald, a Commercial Board or the Civil Defence Commission shall be the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds.

6. The further annual sum payable in terms of Section 1 (1) (e) of the Act shall be the sum of two hundred pounds.

7. The further annual sum payable in terms of Section 1 (1) (f) of the Act shall be the sum of two hundred pounds.

8. The further annual sum payable in terms of Section 1 (1) (g) of the Act shall be the sum of two hundred pounds.

9. The further annual sum payable in terms of Section 2 (1) (a) of the Act shall be the sum of one hundred pounds.

10. The annual sum payable in terms of Section 6 (1) (i) of the Act shall be the sum of two hundred pounds.

11. The annual sum payable in terms of Section 6 (1) (ii) of the Act shall be the sum of seventy five pounds.

12. The sum payable in terms of Section 7 (1) of the Act shall be -

(i) in the case of a person who is a member of a Board of Tynwald and who is not a member of Tynwald the sum of two pounds, and

(ii) in the case of a person who is a member of a Committee of a Board of Tynwald and who is not a member of Tynwald the sum of one pound ten shillings.

13. The maximum sum payable in terms of Section 7 (2) of the Act shall be the sum of seventy five pounds.

14. In this Order the following expression has the meaning hereby assigned to it, that is to say -

"the Act" means the Payment of Members' Expenses Act, 1957, as amended by the Finance Board Act 1961 and the Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1962.

15. The Payment of Members' Expenses Order 1968 (a) is hereby revoked. Provided that such revocation shall not affect any sums payable thereunder on or before 31st March, 1971.

16. (1) This Order may be cited as the Payment of Members' Expenses Order 1970.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on the day it is approved by Tynwald but shall not take effect until the 1st day of April 1971.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has consulted the Joint Committee of Tynwald concerned with the payment of members' expenses and has accepted their recommendations that increases be payable with effect from the 1st April 1971 as set out in the Circular.
