THE DRUGS (PREVENTION OF MISUSE) (ISLE OF MAN)  
ACT 1965 MODIFICATION ORDER 1970

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in pursuance of the power conferred upon me by section 6 of the Drugs (Prevention of Misuse) (Isle of Man) Act 1965 DO HEREBY make the following Order -

1. The substances specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall be added to the Schedule to the Act.

2. The substances specified in Schedule 2 to this Order, together with their salts and substances containing them or their salts, shall be removed from the Schedule to the Act.

3. In accordance with the provisions of this Order the Schedule to the Act shall have effect as set out in the Appendix to this Order (which includes changes in the nomenclature of the substances specified therein).

4. (1) This Order may be cited as the Drugs (Prevention of Misuse) (Isle of Man) Act 1965 Modification Order 1970 and shall have effect from the 1st January 1971.

(2) In this Order "the Act" means the Drugs (Prevention of Misuse) (Isle of Man) Act 1965 as modified by the Drugs (Prevention of Misuse) (Isle of Man) Act 1965 Modification Order 1967 (a)

(3) The Drugs (Prevention of Misuse) (Isle of Man) Act 1965 Modification Order 1967 is hereby revoked.

Article 1

SCHEDULE 1

SUBSTANCES TO BE ADDED TO THE SCHEDULE

(a) Cannabinol and its tetrahydro derivatives, prepared wholly or partly by synthesis, and the 3-alkyl homologues of those substances.

(b) Methaqualone.

(c) N,N-Diethyltryptamine.

(d) N,N-Dimethyltryptamine.

(e) 2,5-Dimethoxy-4,  $\alpha$ -dimethylphenethylamine.

(f) Any stereoisomeric form of a substance specified in any of paragraphs (a) to (e) above.

(g) Any ester or ether of a substance specified in paragraph (a) or (f) above.

(h) Any stereoisomeric form of lysergamide, lysergide and other N-alkyl derivatives of lysergamide.

(i) Any salt of a substance specified in any of paragraphs (a) to (h) above.

(j) Any substance containing any proportion of a substance specified in any of paragraphs (a) to (i) above.

Article 2

SCHEDULE 2

SUBSTANCES TO BE REMOVED FROM THE SCHEDULE

(a) Beta-aminoisopropylbenzene.

(b) Any synthetic compound structurally derived from Beta-aminopropylbenzene or Beta-aminoisopropylbenzene by substitution in the side chain or by ring closure therein (or by both such substituti and such closure), except the following substances, that is to say:-

Benzphetamine.

Fencamfamin.

Mephentermine.

Methylamphetamine.

Methyl Phenidate.

Phendimetrazine.

Phenmetrazine.

Phentermine.

Pipradrol.

Prolintane.

(c) Any Hydroxy-N,N-dimethyltryptamine, except bufotenine and psilocin.

(d) Any ester or ether of any compound falling within paragraph (c) above.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

Under the Drugs (Prevention of Misuse) (Isle of Man) Act 1965 possession, except by certain classes of person specified in the Act, of substances included in the Schedule to the Act is an offence, subject to certain exemptions and exceptions, in particular, possession by virtue of a medical prescription or possession by manufacturers or dealers registered under the Act. The importation of such substances, except under a licence, is prohibited.

This Order adds certain substances to, and removes certain substances from, the Schedule. The substances added are set out in Schedule 1 to the Order; those removed are set out in Schedule 2 and include ambutionium bromide, doxapram, diethylpropion and phenatine.

The Schedule to the Act will now have effect as set out in the Appendix to the Order which includes changes of nomenclature and, in particular replaces the generic formula hitherto contained in paragraph 3 by references to specific substances falling within that formula. The principal substances not previously controlled by the Act are shown in CAPITALS in the Appendix to the Order.
