DECIMAL CURRENCY (ISLE OF MAN) ACT 1970

DECIMAL CURRENCY (ISLE OF MAN) ORDER 1971

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by section 10(1)(a) of the Decimal Currency (Isle of Man) Act 1970 DO hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Decimal Currency (Isle of Man) Order 1971.
2. The Interpretation Act 1970 shall apply in respect of this Order as it does in respect of an Act of Tynwald.
3. The Order shall take effect when approved by resolution of Tynwald.
4. In the rules of the Companies Winding Up Rules 1934 mentioned in the first column of the Schedule to this Order, for the references to the amounts mentioned in the second column there shall be substituted references to the amounts mentioned in the third column thereto.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

In that the equivalent in the new currency of the sums in the old currency mentioned in the Schedule, as provided for by section 9 of the Decimal Currency (Isle of Man) Act 1970, could not be paid in coins of the new currency this Order specifies an amount that can be so paid. This Order operates notwithstanding the terms of section 9 of the said Act of 1970.
