THE MANX DECIMAL COINS ACT 1970

THE MANX CROWNS (TREATMENT AS MANX DECIMAL COINS) ORDER 1971

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by paragraph (e) of section two of the Manx Decimal Coins Act 1970, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, after consultation with the Finance Board, do hereby make the following Order -

1. (1) This Order may be cited as The Manx Crowns (Treatment as Manx Decimal Coins) Order 1971.  
(2) The Order shall take effect on the date it is approved by Tynwald.
2. Manx Crowns issued in accordance with the Coinage (Manx Crowns) Act 1970 shall on and after the date on which this Order takes effect be treated as Manx decimal coins of twenty-five new pence denomination.
