CORONERS OF INQUESTS ACT 1961

CORONER'S JURY RULES 1971

I, the said Lieutenant Governor in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 32 of the Coroners of Inquests Act 1961 and of all other powers me in this behalf enabling DO HEREBY make the following Rules:-

1. Every person serving as a juror at an inquest shall be entitled to the following remuneration for his services, that is to say -

(a) at the rate of £4. 0. 0. for every full day of the inquest; and

(b) wherever on any day the inquest sits during only one half of that day, at the rate of £2. 0. 0.

2. Every person who in obedience to a summons to serve as a juror at an inquest attends for such service but is not sworn as a juror shall be entitled to be paid at the same rate as if he were serving as a juror.

3. Rule 2 of the Coroners Rules 1961 is hereby revoked.

4. These Rules may be cited as the Coroner's Jury Rules 1971 and shall come into operation when approved by Tynwald.
