JURY ACT 1960

JURORS ORDER 1971

I, the said Lieutenant Governor in exercise of the power conferred on me by section 34 of the Jury Act 1960 and of all other powers me in this behalf enabling DO HEREBY order as follows:-

1. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 34 of the Jury Act 1960 are hereby repealed and the following subsections substituted therefor -

"(1) Every juror trying a case, whether civil or criminal, shall be entitled to the following remuneration for his services, that is to say -

(a) at the rate of £4. 0. 0. for every full day of the trial; and

(b) wherever on any day the trial sits during only one half of that day, at the rate of £2. 0. 0.

(2) Every person who in obedience to a summons to serve as a juror attends for such service but is not sworn as a juror shall be entitled to be paid at the same rate as if he were trying a case."

2. This Order may be cited as the Jurors Order 1971 and shall take effect on the day when it is approved by Tynwald.
