THE GAS REGULATION ACT 1927

THE GAS (PRESCRIBED CALORIFIC VALUE) (VILLAGE
DISTRICT OF ONCHAN) ORDER, 1971.

WHEREAS the Douglas Gas Light Company have made application to me for approval to an increase in the calorific value of gas supplied by the Company to consumers in the Village District of Onchan from 500 British Thermal Units per cubic foot to 625 British Thermal Units per cubic foot because of proposed changes to butane/air plant system of supply

AND WHEREAS I ordered an enquiry to be held under section 4 of the Gas Regulation Act 1927 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and the report of the qualified gas referee thereon recommends me to make such an Order

AND WHEREAS my intention to make such an Order was published in newspapers circulating in the Isle of Man and no objection thereto has been received.

NOW, therefore, I, the said Lieutenant Governor in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 4 and 6(1) of the Act DO hereby
ORDER -

- (1) THAT with effect from the date referred to in paragraph (3) hereof the prescribed calorific value of gas to be supplied to the Village District of Onchan by Douglas Gas Light Company shall be 625 British Thermal Units per cubic foot ascertained as prescribed by section 9 of the Act;

(2) THAT the Douglas Gas Light Company shall take at their own expense such steps as may be necessary to alter adjust or replace the burners and consumers' appliances as to secure that such gas can be burned with safety and efficiency except in the case of any consumer who objects to any such alteration adjustment or replacement by such Company;

(3) THAT the Douglas Gas Light Company shall publish notice of the date of opening of the proposed new plant producing gas of such calorific value in such manner as may be approved by me.

AND I DO FURTHER ORDER that the Order of the Lieutenant Governor dated the 21st day of October 1929 made under the Gas Regulation Act 1927 relating to the Douglas Gas Light Company shall be amended by the insertion of the following paragraph next after paragraph 1 of that Order:-

"1A. That the Douglas Gas Light Company shall on and after a date to be prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor supply gas for public use in the Village District of Onchan of the standard calorific value of not less than 625 British Thermal Units ascertained as prescribed by section 9 of such Act and such value shall be deemed to be the prescribed calorific value of the gas supplied by such Company in such district for the purposes of the said Act and of any other Acts relating to or affecting the Gas Company."
