ORDER, 1971.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in
exercise of the powers conferred upon me by
section 1 of the Gross & Rateable Values (Special
Variations) Act 1971 and of all other powers
me in this behalf enabling, and having
consulted with the Isle of Man Assessment Board,
DO hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Gross and Rateable Values (Special Variations) Order 1971 and shall take effect on the 12th day of May 1971.
2. The enactments specified in the Schedule to this Order shall have effect subject to the amendments specified in the second column of that Schedule.
