LICENSING ACT, 1961.

LICENSING ORDER, 1971.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 173 of the Licensing Act 1961 that the Governor may by Order provide that during such period or periods as may be specified in the Order the amendments to the Licensing Acts which are specified in such Order shall have effect

AND WHEREAS the following Conferences will be held in the Isle of Man during the periods stated:-

Civil and Public Services Association	15th - 22nd May, 1971
N.A.L.G.O.	19th - 26th June, 1971
Rotary International District 105	1st - 4th Octr. 1971.

AND WHEREAS it has been represented to me that difficulties as to the licensing laws may arise during late-night sittings and subsequent discussions between delegates staying in different Hotels and in relation to hospitality which the Conferences wish to extend to official guests

NOW, therefore, I, the said Lieutenant Governor in pursuance of the powers vested in me by such Act DO hereby Order as follows:-

1. During the following periods, all dates inclusive, but in respect of the dates in column 2 only until the hour of one o'clock in the morning, the Licensing Act 1961 shall have effect as if section 100 were amended by the addition at the end of subsection (2) thereof of the following paragraph:

"(k) the sale of or supply to, or consumption by delegates to the Civil and Public Services Association Conference; N.A.L.G.O. Conference and Rotary International Conference District 105 and their spouses and their official guests of intoxicating liquor from the end of the permitted hours in public houses on any such day until the hour of one o'clock in the morning on the next following day:

Provided that this paragraph shall apply only to the following hotels, that is to say, the Castletown Golf Links Hotel, Castle Mona Hotel, Central Hotel, Queen's Hotel, Douglas, Fort Anne Hotel, Sefton Hotel, Metropole Hotel, Douglas Bay Hotel, Villiers Hotel, Athol Hotel and Imperial Hotel.
