LICENSING ACT, 1961.

LICENSING (No. 2) ORDER, 1971.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 173 of the Licensing Act 1961 that the Governor may by Order provide that during such period or periods as may be specified in the Order the amendments to the Licensing Acts which are specified in such Order shall have effect.

AND WHEREAS the Governor in pursuance of the said section 173 duly made the Licensing Order 1971 whereunder section 100 of the said Act was amended so as to permit in certain hotels during the periods (inter alia) 19th June 1971 to 27th June 1971 and 1st October 1971 to 5th October 1971, all dates inclusive, the sale or supply to, or consumption by delegates to (inter alia) the N.A.L.G.O. Conference and the Rotary International Conference District 105 and their spouses and official guests of intoxicating liquor from the end of the permitted hours in public houses on any such day until the hour of one o'clock in the morning on the next following day.

AND WHEREAS included among such hotels was the Imperial Hotel which no longer desires the benefit of the said amendment.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the Majestic Hotel in the Village District of Onchan should have the benefit of the said amendment.

NOW, therefore, I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the said Act DO hereby Order as follows:-

2.

1. In the proviso to Article 1. of the Licensing Order 1971 for the words "Imperial Hotel" there shall be substituted the words "Majestic Hotel".
2. This Order may be cited as the Licensing (No.2) Order 1971.
