

SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCES

By Resolution dated 6th July, 1971, Tynwald approved of the payment to Members of Tynwald, Officials, Members of the Civil Service and such other persons as the Governor may from time to time by Order direct, of subsistence and out-of-pocket allowances, in respect of absences from the Island on official business commencing on or after the 1st July, 1971, as follows:-

1. (1) When a period of absence -

(a) Does not exceed 7 days -

the rates of subsistence allowance payable shall be -

£8. per day in London  
£6.75 per day elsewhere.

(b) Exceeds 7 days but does not exceed 21 days -

the rates of subsistence allowance payable shall be -

£6.75 per day for first 14 days in London  
£5.65 per day for remaining days in London  
£5.65 per day elsewhere for first 14 days  
£3.40 per day elsewhere for remaining days.

(c) Exceeds 21 days -

the rates of subsistence allowance payable shall be -

£5.65 per day in London for the full period  
£3.40 per day elsewhere for the full period.

(2) The rates specified in the preceding sub-paragraphs of this paragraph shall be reduced by an appropriate amount in respect of any meal provided free of charge by any Manx public authority or public body during the period to which the allowance relates.

The appropriate amount for a dinner shall be 85p, and for a luncheon shall be 70p.

- (3) In this paragraph, "London" means that area lying within a four-mile radius of Charing Cross (i.e. the area to which the Inner London Pay Area of the United Kingdom Civil Service applies) and includes the London Airport hotels; and "elsewhere" means any other place within the British Isles.
2. When a period of absence is for the purpose of attending a training course or conference, etc., when food and accommodation are provided free of charge, an allowance at the rate of £1.15 per day only for out-of-pocket expenses shall be payable.
3. When Members of the Legislature attend meetings of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association at which full accommodation is provided free of charge to the Members, a daily allowance at the rate of £3.40 only shall be payable.
4. The day on which the person concerned arrives back on the Island shall not be reckonable for the purposes of the foregoing paragraphs of this Resolution unless his time of arrival on the Island that day is later than noon, in which case the allowance in respect of that day shall be £1.70 only.
5. When the person concerned travels from and arrives back on the Island on the same day, an allowance of £1.70 only shall be payable.
6. This Resolution shall not apply to persons employed by the Isle of Man Tourist Board as travelling representatives.
7. The rates of allowances authorised by Resolution of Tynwald of the 18th February, 1969 (Government Circular 20/69) are hereby revoked.
