THE HYDROCARBON OILS (REBATE) ORDER 1971

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by resolutions of Tynwald of the 21st May, 1963, 19th January, 1965, 11th December, 1968, and 15th June, 1971, and of all other powers me in that behalf enabling do hereby make the following Order:-

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| Rebate Scheme | 1. Grants will be paid by the Government Treasurer to the road services operators (hereinafter called "the operators") described in the Schedule hereto in respect of approved hydrocarbon oils used by the operators in the running of approved scheduled services. |
| Amount of Rebate | 2. The amount of the Grant shall be twenty pence per gallon in respect of approved hydrocarbon oils delivered to the operators on or after 1st April, 1970, and on or before 31st March, 1973, provided that the total amount of the Grant payable to the Transport Department of Douglas Corporation in respect of any year shall not result in a surplus on the amalgamated accounts of the Department for that year. In amalgamating the accounts of the Sections of the Department for this purpose the actual capital cost of replacements or renewals incurred and paid in the year shall be substituted for the contributions to the Renewals and Replacements Accounts normally included in such accounts. |

3. If, in any year, the amount of advances on account of grant result in a surplus as set out in Paragraph 2 hereof, the Transport Department of Douglas Corporation shall repay the excess grant to the Government Treasurer.

Claims

4. Claims shall be submitted by the operators in duplicate in the prescribed form to the Government Treasurer at the end of each month endorsed "I/We hereby certify that this is a true and correct return of the total quantities of approved hydro-carbon oils used in the running of approved scheduled services and for no other purposes. And I/We hereby further certify that duty at the appropriate rate has been paid thereon" and signed by a duly authorised officer of the operators.

Inspection

5. It shall be a condition precedent to the receipt of any advances on account of grant under this scheme that the operators shall afford all reasonable and proper facilities to an officer or officers of Finance Department, duly authorised in that behalf by the Government Treasurer, to satisfy himself by inspection of the relevant books and records of the operators that any claim under this Scheme is true and correct.

Interpretation

6. In this Order, "approved" and "prescribed" mean approved and prescribed respectively by the Finance Board.

Citation and Commencement

7. This Order may be cited as the Hydro-carbon Oils (Rebate) Order 1971, and shall be deemed to have taken effect on 1st April 1970.

Revocation

8. The Hydrocarbon Oils (Rebate) Order 1968 is hereby revoked.
