**Representation of the People (Table of  
Fees) (Amendment) Order, 1971**

---

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by Section 75 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, DO hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Table of Fees set forth in the Sixth Schedule to the Representation of the People Act, 1951, as amended by the Representation of the People (Table of Fees) (No. 1 Amendment) Order, 1956, and the Representation of the People (Table of Fees) (No. 2 Amendment) Order, 1956 and the Representation of the People (Table of Fees) (Amendment) Order, 1964 shall be further amended as hereinafter prescribed.

2. For paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 of the said Table of Fees, the following paragraphs shall be substituted:—

"4. A Returning Officer for an election in case there be no poll, including the preparation of all advertisements, and any other work necessary to be done in the case of an uncontested election, a fee of ... .. £22

5. And in case there be a poll, (besides the necessary expenses that may be incurred by him) an additional fee of ... .. £22 and where the number of electors on the list of voters for the constituency exceeds 1,500 a further £1.50 for every 100 electors or portion of a hundred in excess of 1,500.

(Such fee to include all necessary time occupied in inspecting and arranging for polling places and the erection of voting compartments, preparing ballot papers and notices required by the Representation of the People Acts, 1951 to 1971, and all other duties imposed by such Acts.)

6. A deputy returning officer in case there be no poll ... ..	£6.50
And in case there be a poll (including assisting at the count) ... ..	£14.50
A presiding officer in case there be no poll ...	£2.00
A presiding officer in case there be a poll (including assisting at the count) ... ..	£11.00
A poll clerk in case there be no poll ... ..	£2.00
A poll clerk in case there be a poll (including assisting at the count) ... ..	£7.50
An additional officer to assist at the count ...	£3.50''

3. (1) This Order may be cited as the Representation of the People (Table of Fees) (Amendment) Order, 1971.

(2) This Order and the Orders referred to in Article 1 of this Order may together be cited as the Representation of the People (Table of Fees) Amendment Orders, 1956 to 1971.

4. This Order shall take effect when approved by resolution of Tynwald.
