SPORTS COUNCIL FOR THE ISLE OF MAN

WHEREAS Tynwald passed the following resolution  
on the 18th November, 1970:-

" That Tynwald requests His Excellency to  
appoint a Sports Council for the Isle of Man  
with the following terms of reference -

- (a) To encourage the development of amateur sport and physical recreation;
- (b) To review existing sports facilities;
- (c) To advise Government departments, local authorities and voluntary organisations concerned on ways and means of improving existing facilities and of providing new facilities;
- (d) To foster co-ordination of the use of existing resources;
- (e) To assist financially, or in any other way, in the provision of sports facilities, in training and coaching, and in the participation by local persons in amateur sporting events in the Isle of Man and overseas. "
