**S.4 PULROSE POLLING DISTRICT  
(EXTENSION) ORDER 1971**

---

WHEREAS by Section forty nine (3) of the Representation of the People Act 1951 (hereinafter called "the principal Act") it is provided that the polling districts of the town constituencies shall be such as may from time to time be specified by the Isle of Man Local Government Board (hereinafter called "the Board") by Order; Provided that the Board may from time to time by Order vary polling districts.

AND WHEREAS on the 25th day of May 1956 the Board made an Order defining the polling districts of the town constituencies of North Douglas, South Douglas, East Douglas and West Douglas as delineated on the plan annexed thereto and signed by the Chairman of the Board.

AND WHEREAS with the passing of the Douglas Extension of Boundary Act 1969 an area formerly part of the Parish of Braddan which the boundaries of the Borough of Douglas were extended to include with effect from the 12th day of May 1968 by a resolution of Tynwald passed on the 18th day of June 1968, such area being delineated and coloured "pink" on the plan attached to a report of a Committee of Tynwald dated 7th day of May 1968 and filed in the General Registry on the 24th day of June 1968, and designated "the extended area".

NOW THEREFORE the Board in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section forty nine (3) of the principal Act and of all other powers it in that behalf enabling

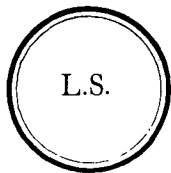
DOTH HEREBY ORDER:—

**1.** That as from and after the 12th day of May 1971 the extended area be added to the Polling District S.4 Pulrose of the Constituency of South Douglas.

**2.** (1) This Order may be cited as the S.4 Pulrose Polling District (Extension) Order 1971 and shall be read as one with the Order relating to the Polling Districts of the Town Constituencies of North Douglas, South Douglas, East Douglas and West Douglas made by the Board on the 25th day of May 1956 and that Order and this Order may be together cited as the Douglas Polling Districts Orders 1956 and 1971.

(2) The said Order of the 25th May 1956 may hereafter be cited as The Douglas Polling Districts Order 1956.

The Common Seal of the Isle of Man Local Government Board was hereunto affixed this 29th day of June 1971 in pursuance of a Resolution for this purpose duly passed at a Meeting of the Board held on the 18th day of June 1971 in the presence of
