**THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE
ACTS 1951 TO 1971**

**MAUGHOLD POLLING DISTRICTS
ORDER 1971**

WHEREAS by Section 49 Sub-Section (2) of the Representation of the People Act 1951 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), it is provided that the Isle of Man Local Government Board (hereinafter called "the Board", may from time to time by Order vary Polling Districts in sheding constituencies specified in the Third Schedule to the said Act.

AND WHEREAS it is considered desirable to vary the Polling Districts specified in Paragraphs 15, 16 and 17 of the Third Schedule to the said Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Board in exercise of the powers vested in the Board by Sub-Section (2) of Section 49 of the said Act and of all other powers it in that behalf enabling DO HEREBY ORDER:—

That the Polling Districts specified in Paragraphs 15, 16 and 17 of the Third Schedule to the said Act shall, as and from the 12th day of May 1972 be varied as follows:—

1. For paragraph 15 the following paragraph shall be substituted:—

"The north Maughold Polling District of Garff shall include that portion of the Parish of Maughold which lies north and north east of a line drawn from a point at high water mark at Port Cornaa where the Balla-

glass River enters the sea, along the centre of the said Ballaglass River to where it meets the main Douglas/Ramsey road at The Coronny, up the centre of the Douglas/Ramsey road to where it meets the road from Magher-e-Kew, then in a straight line to the summit of North Barrule."

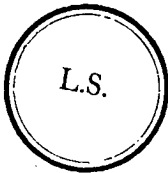
2. For paragraph 16 the following paragraph shall be substituted:—

"The South Maughold Polling District of Garff shall include that portion of the Parish of Maughold which is not included in the North Maughold Polling District."

3. Paragraph 17 shall be deleted.

4. This Order may be cited as the Maughold Polling Districts Order 1971.

The Common Seal of the Isle of Man Local Government Board was hereunto annexed this 29th day of June 1971 in pursuance of a Resolution for this purpose duly passed at a Meeting of the Board held on the 18th day of June 1971 in the presence of
