INQUESTS OF DEATH ACTS
REMUNERATION OF DEPUTY CORONER

WHEREAS under Section 1(5) of the Coroners of Inquests Act 1961 it is enacted that there shall be paid to any deputy or acting coroner appointed under the provisions of the Act out of monies provided by Tynwald, such remuneration as may be determined from time to time by the Governor.

NOW I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in pursuance of the said section DO hereby order and determine that there shall be paid out of monies provided by Tynwald -

- (1) in respect of each inquest undertaken by a deputy coroner appointed in accordance with the Coroners of Inquests Act 1961 the following remuneration:-

For each day in which attendance at an inquest exceeds four hours,
the sum of £11.00.

For each day in which attendance at an inquest does not exceed four hours,
the sum of £ 5.50.

- (2) in respect of all duties undertaken by a deputy coroner appointed as aforesaid in pursuance of Section 25 of the Coroners of Inquests Act 1961 in each case where an inquest is unnecessary,
the sum of £ 2.00.

- (3) in respect of the issue of any order in terms of the Civil Registration and Dissenters Marriages Act, 1933 (other than an Order in terms of Section 3(1) of the said Act) or of any regulations made under the said Act,
the sum of 52½p.
- (4) in respect of any order required to be made under the Cremation Act, 1902 (an Act of Parliament) or any regulation made thereunder,
the sum of£ 1.05.
- (5) in respect of a Coroner's Certificate in Form "E" of the Schedule to the Cremation Regulations, 1957,
the sum of £ 1.05.

together with:

- (a) travelling expenses actually incurred by a deputy coroner attending an inquest or performing any such duties as aforesaid including the cost of first class return railway fares; or
- (b) the allowance payable in terms of the Motor Mileage Allowances Order for the time being in force.

Government Circular No. 43/61 of 12th April 1961 is hereby cancelled.

This determination shall have effect from 1st April 1971.
