AN ORDER TO REPEAL SECTION 4 OF THE  
MENTAL DISEASES ACT 1924 AND THE RULES  
AND REGULATIONS FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND  
CONDUCT OF THE ISLE OF MAN MENTAL  
HOSPITAL, 1947.

WHEREAS Rules and Regulations for the management and conduct of the Isle of Man Mental Hospital were made by the Isle of Man Health Services Board in 1947, under section 4 of the Mental Diseases Act 1924.

AND WHEREAS it has been made to appear to me by the said Board that these Rules and Regulations are not relevant to the present circumstances, and that section 4 of the Mental Diseases Act 1924 has been made redundant in consequence of the passing of the National Health Service (Isle of Man) Act 1948.

NOW THEREFORE I the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by subsection (1) of section 62 of the National Health Service (Isle of Man) Act 1948 DO HEREBY ORDER that section 4 of the Mental Diseases Act 1924 be repealed from the date hereof and accordingly that the Rules and Regulations for the management and conduct of the Isle of Man Mental Hospital 1947 made under the Act shall cease to have effect.
