MANX DECIMAL COINS ACT 1970

MANX DECIMAL COINS (MISCELLANEOUS COINS DESIGNS) ORDER 1971

WHEREAS the issue by the Treasurer of Manx decimal coins of cupro nickel of the denomination of ten new pence and five new pence and of bronze of the denomination of two new pence, a new penny and a new half penny has been sanctioned by me and approved by Tynwald in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of the Manx Decimal Coins Act 1970, I the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by section 2 of the said Manx Decimal Coins Act, and after consultation with the Finance Board, DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:-

1. Each of the said coins shall for the obverse impression have a portrait of Her Majesty with the inscription "ELIZABETH THE SECOND" and the date of the year.
2. Each of the said coins of the metal and denomination specified in the first column of the Schedule to the Order shall on the reverse side bear an impression of the matter described in relation thereto in the second column of the Schedule, the inscription "ISLE OF MAN" and its denomination in words.
3. Each of the said coins being of the denomination of ten new pence or five new pence shall have a milled edge and being of any other denomination shall have a plain edge.
4. This Order shall be entitled the Manx Decimal Coins (Miscellaneous Coins Designs) Order 1971.
5. This Order shall come into force upon its being approved by Tynwald.
