

THE MEDICINES ACT 1976

THE MEDICINES SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION (APPLICATION NO. 13)
ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry and the Department of Local Government and the Environment by sections 57, 58, 75, 76 and 121(7) of the Medicines Act 1976(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Medicines Subsidiary Legislation (Application No. 13) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 1st March 1990.

Application of U.K. subsidiary legislation

2. (1) The provisions of the Orders and Regulations made under the Medicines Act 1968(b) (an Act of Parliament) specified in Schedule 1 shall apply to the Island subject to the modifications and adaptations specified in Schedules 2 and 3.

(2) Subject to sub-paragraph (3), any provision in an Order or Regulations applied by this Order shall be construed as having effect from the date specified in Article 1.

(3) If any provision of an Order or Regulations applied by this Order is to have effect in the United Kingdom from a date after the date specified in Article 1, that provision shall be construed as having effect from that later date.

Amendment and revocation

3. (1) The Medicines Subsidiary Legislation (Application) Order 1978(c) is amended by the substitution, for the words in column 3 of Schedule 10 (which modifies regulation 3 of the Medicines (Pharmacies) (Applications for Registration and Fees) Regulations 1973(d) in its application to the Isle of Man), of the word "Omit".

(2) The Orders specified in Schedule 4 are revoked to the extent specified in column 3 of that Schedule.

Commencement

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order applies to the Isle of Man -

the Medicines (Medicated Animal Feeding Stuff) Regulations 1988 (SI 1988/877), which consolidate with amendments earlier Regulations (applied to the Isle of Man) controlling the inclusion of medicinal products in animal feeding stuffs, and the import and supply of feeding stuffs in which such products have been incorporated; and

the Medicines (Products Other Than Veterinary Drugs) (Prescription Only) Amendment Order 1988 (S.I. 1988/2017), which makes minor amendments to an Order (SI 1983/1212, applied to the Isle of Man) specifying medicinal products which may not be supplied except on prescription.

The Order also revokes earlier orders superseded by this Order or related legislation.
