THE MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT 1976

THE MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT 1976 (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Local Government and the Environment by section 2 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1976(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Act 1976 (Amendment) Order 1990 and, subject to section 2(4) of the Act, shall come into operation on the 1st April 1990.

(2) In this Order "the Act" means the Misuse of Drugs Act 1976.

Amendment of the Act

2. Schedule 2 to the Act (which specifies the drugs which are subject to control under the Act) is amended by the insertion in paragraph of Part II -

(a) after the word "Bromazepam", of the word "Buprenophine"; and

(b) after the word "Oxazolam", of the word "Pemoline".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order adds Buprenophine and Pemoline to Part III of Schedule 2 to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1976 (which specifies the Class C drugs which are subject to control under the Act).
