Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

MARKET STREET (DOUGLAS)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Market Street (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic Order) 1990 and shall come into operation on the 14th January, 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Market Street in the Borough of Douglas, adjacent to the property situated thereon and numbered 23.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the works to be carried out.

Suspension of One-Way Traffic

4. The provisions of the One Way Traffic Streets Order, 1981 shall cease to have effect in respect of item 20 Market Street during the period that this Order is in force.

Duration

5. This Order shall continue in force until the 21st January, 1990 or until the electrical connection work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic, the length of Market Street, Douglas adjacent to the property situated thereon numbered 23, during the period work is being undertaken.

The one way traffic system over Market Street between Nelson Street and the Greeba Works is suspended for the period the temporary closure operates.
