Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

LANE AT REAR OF WEST SIDE OF RIDGEWAY STREET (DOUGLAS)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Lane at Rear of West Side of Ridgeway Street (Douglas) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 15th January 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No vehicular or pedestrian traffic shall proceed in that length of the lane situated behind the west side of Ridgeway Street in the Borough of Douglas, which abutts the rear of the Wheatsheaf Hotel.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the works to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until the demolition and re-development works are completed.
