Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

STATION ROAD (BALLASALLA)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Station Road (Ballasalla) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on 29th January 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Station Road in the village of Ballasalla from its junction with Douglas Road to its junction with the entrance road to Silverburn Estate.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles -
 - (a) engaged in the works to be carried out; or
 - (b) authorised by the contractor, Marty Downey (1982) Limited.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until the 30th April 1990, or until the drainage work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic, except authorised traffic, that length of Station Road, Ballasalla from its junction with Douglas Road to Silverburn Estate for the period that drainage works are being undertaken.
