



CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACTS (APPLICATION) ACT 1975

CUSTOMS DUTIES (APPLICATION) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 1 of the Customs and Excise Acts (Application) Act 1975(a), and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation, commencement and construction

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Application) Order 1990 and shall be construed as one with the Customs and Excise Acts (Application) Order 1979(b).

(2) Subject to section 1(4) of the Customs and Excise Acts (Application) Act 1975, the applied legislation shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January 1990.

Interpretation

2. In this Order "the applied legislation" means the instruments of a legislative character specified in Schedule 1.

Application

3. The applied legislation shall apply to the Island, as part of the law of the Island, subject to the exceptions, modifications and adaptations specified in Schedules 2 and 3.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order applies to the Island two United Kingdom statutory instruments relating to customs duty:-

1. The Customs Duty (Personal Reliefs) (Amendment) Order 1989 increases the travellers allowance for goods other than alcohol and tobacco, obtained duty and tax paid by Community travellers, from £250 to £265.
2. The Customs Duties (ECSC) (Quota and Other Reliefs) Order 1989 provides for reliefs and exemptions from customs duty on certain iron and steel products which originate in particular countries, usually third world and developing countries.
