Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

WALPOLE AVENUE (DOUGLAS)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Walpole Avenue (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 29th January, 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in Walpole Avenue in the Borough of Douglas.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to -
  - (a) vehicles engaged in the works to be undertaken; and
  - (b) such traffic as may be authorised by the Douglas Corporation.

Suspension of One Way Traffic

4. The provisions of the One Way Traffic Streets Order 1981 shall cease to have effect in respect of item 43 Walpole Avenue during the period that this Order is in force.

Duration

5. This Order shall continue in force until the 2nd April, 1990, or until the sewer work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note  
(This Note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic, except authorised traffic, the whole of Walpole Avenue, Douglas, during the period sewer repair works are being undertaken.
