Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

CORRANY ESTATE ROAD (MAUGHOLD)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Corransy Estate Road (Maughold) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 3rd February, 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of the access road into the Corransy Housing Estate in the Parish of Maughold, over a distance of 50 metres from its junction with the Laxey/Ramsey coast road.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the works to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until the 4th February, 1990 or until the water work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic, the 50 metres of the access road into Corransy Housing Estate, Maughold, nearest the main Laxey/Ramsey coast road, for a 2 day period or until water works are completed, whichever is the earlier.
