Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

PARKING PLACES (ONCHAN) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by sections 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Onchan) (Amendment) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 6th March, 1990.

Interpretation

2. In this Order:-

"Regulations means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981 made by the Secretary of State for Transport, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales as they have effect in the Isle of Man by virtue of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1982 (b).

Amendment to Principal Order

3. The Schedule to the Parking Places (Onchan) Order 1983, shall be amended by the insertion, after entry number 11, of the following entry:-

Church Road	As indicated by the road marking shown in diagram 1028.1 of the Regulations.	Southern side wholly within the limits of the parking place and parallel to the kerb with the offside of the vehicle adjacent to the edge of the carriageway.	Unlimited	Unlimited	Disabled persons vehicle	No lights required "
