Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

CASTLE STREET (PEEL)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Castle Street (Peel) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 14th February 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No vehicular traffic shall proceed along that section of Castle Street in the town of Peel which fronts the property situated thereon and numbered 8.

Suspension of One-way Traffic System

3. During the period this Order is in force the one-way traffic system imposed on Castle Street by paragraph (2) (e) of the Road Traffic Regulations 1981 is suspended.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force for the whole of the 14th February, 1990, or until electricity connection work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
