Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

PARKING PLACES (CASTLETOWN) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by sections 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Castletown) (Amendment) Order 1990, and shall come into operation on the 19th February, 1990.

Interpretation

2. In this Order:-

"Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981 made by the Secretary of State for Transport, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales as they have effect in the Isle of Man by virtue of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1982 (b).

Amendment to Principal Order

3. The Parking Places Order 1980 made by the Castletown Commissioners shall be further amended by the addition, in the Fourth Schedule after paragraph number 19, of the following entry:-

Explanatory Note

The effect of this Order is to authorise for use a parking place for one disabled persons vehicle on the northwest side of The Crofts, Castletown, outside the property numbered 22 thereon.
