Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

CHURCH ROAD (PORT ERIN) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Church Road (Port Erin) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 20th March, 1990.

Restriction on Waiting

2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the side of the length of road specified in the Schedule:-
 - (a) for a longer period than 30 minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than two hours has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the side of the length of road.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the side of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations:-
 - (i) building or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said side of the length of road;

- (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said side of the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication apparatus (within the meaning of the Telecommunications Act 1984) kept or to be kept installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system (within the meaning of that Act);
- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or
- (e) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

4. Amendment

- (a) The Village District of Port Erin (Various Roads) (Prohibition & Restriction of Waiting) Order 1974 shall be amended as follows -
- (b) In the entry for Church Road for the words "Cherry Orchard" substitute the words "the western side of the lay-bye."

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to limit, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m., the waiting of any vehicle in the lay-bye on the northern side of Church Road, Port Erin, to a maximum period of 30 minutes; and to prohibit any vehicle having so waited from again waiting until 2 hours have elapsed.
